SUMMARY

Briefly summarise the podcast content. Keep your summary short: use dot points, focus on the intended audience, purpose and main points. People are less likely to read a long summary. Try to limit it to a paragraph. If possible, include the presenter's credentials, this allows the reader to determine the credibility of the source.

SCIENCE COMMUNICATION

Consider the podcast

- What features of the podcast make it engaging for the audience?
- How effectively do the presenters communicate scientific ideas?

SCIENCE CREDIBILITY

Consider the quality of scientific ideas

- Are there evidence the ideas are supported by science?
- Why might you trust the presenter's credentials?

FINAL THOUGHTS

- What wonderings or unanswered questions, do you have?
- What else do you think a prospective listener should know?

SIMILAR PODCASTS YOU MIGHT LIKE

- Locate and list other podcasts on similar topics that you think listeners might enjoy.
- Suggest reasons for these choices.
